Thank you for participating in the SAMBA resident mentorship program. In hopes of providing fruitful mentorship over the next year for resident members, we have outlined some guidelines for the SAMBA mentorship.

SAMBA Resident Mentorship guidelines:

1. Make contact with your mentor member via email or telephone as soon as possible. ***Your mentor expects that you will contact them and head up all communication.***
2. Complete the “Roadmap for Success” Worksheet.
3. Discuss the worksheet with your mentor and work with them to develop a plan to develop and attain your career goals. The mentor’s perspective and experience are extremely valuable in this process.
4. Review your CV with your mentor and seek his or her help with any formatting or content issues.
5. If possible, settle on a time to meet in person during a coffee break at the annual meeting and/or at the mid-year meeting/ASA.
6. If interested, discuss submitting an abstract for presentation at the SAMBA annual meeting in Miami, Florida in May.
7. If interested, discuss with your mentor joining a SAMBA committee.
